







The Alternative Archive Exhibition - *Nganana* is a series of interconnected group exhibitions that are delivered by the Connect to the Creative grid project, through Regional Arts Partnership Program (RAPP), and supported by the State Government of Western Australia and Country Arts WA.

Artists are recorders of social history, the creators of cultural capital in any community and the creative output is central to understanding our sense of identity, place and community.

The Alternative Archive Exhibition - *Nganana* brings together contemporary artists living throughout regional Western Australia to participate in a statewide exhibition network that engages with their local social contexts. Artists and arts groups are invited to create a visual archive drawn from personal relationships with people, places and stories around them that they feel should be highlighted. We see a construction of a dynamic new anthology of artworks and outcomes which encompass a diverse range of artistic voices.
